



## BACK TO SCHOOL: IN PERSON & ONLINE

The Fall 2020 semester marks the beginning of our third school year in operation, and the CLC is now offering Bible courses during two class periods every school day! **A total of 26 students from Campbell County High School are taking our Creation to Christ course this semester.** We have a class of 15, a class of 9, and an online class of 2 virtual learners. Virtual learners are studying the same course material asynchronously via reading and video assignments posted on Google Classroom along with weekly video conferences for instruction. This semester, our classes have been taught by CLC teacher and program director, Stephanie Lloyd. **After many difficult months away from school, it is wonderful for students to be back in our classroom, studying the Bible together and discovering truth daily.**

Because of the generous partnership of individuals, churches, and local businesses, the Christian Learning Center staff have been thrilled to see our number of students grow. Ashley Claiborne, CLC's executive director, has made great efforts in advocating for this ministry to our community and within Campbell County Schools. **Our goal is to work alongside CCHS staff to offer help and hope to those in the local public school system.** When students recognize the CLC as a place of encouragement, biblical teaching, and fun, the word spreads to their peers. Please pray for our students as they learn to navigate God's Word and make decisions about how to respond to it's message of salvation and discipleship.
